BY THE COMMISSION:

By joint application filed April 5, 2001, Coyote Network Systems, Inc. (Coyote) of Los Angeles, California; Coyote-GLD Acquisition, Inc. of Fort Lauderdale, Florida; and Group Long Distance, Inc. (GLD) of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, seek to abandon the agreement and plan of merger requested and approved in C-2352. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 6, 2001. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On September 19, 2000, the Commission granted Application No. C-2352, approving a proposed plan of merger in which GLD merged with and into a wholly-owned subsidiary of Coyote.

On April 3, 2001, the Commission received notice from the parties to the merger of their intention to abandon the proposed transaction which was approved in Application No. C-2352. Both Coyote and GLD request that the prior approval be withdrawn. In light of this request and the abandonment of the proposed merger, the Commission finds that such prior approval given in Application No. C-2352 should be withdrawn.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2512 be, and it is hereby, granted.


