## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 9, 2001, pursuant to Application No. C-2543, City-Net Telecom Inc. (CityNet) of Silver Spring, Maryland, was granted authority to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide interexchange telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

By letter dated June 4, 2001, CityNet has requested that its certificate be canceled. CityNet has recently reviewed its marketing plan and has determined that resold interexchange certification is not necessary for its operations. CityNet has not provided any services within the state of Nebraska, therefore, no customers would be impacted by the withdrawal.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide interexchange telecommunications services previously issued in Application No. C-2349 to CityNet Telcom, Inc., be, and it is hereby, canceled.
