No change in rates, terms or conditions of Aliant Midwest's provisions of telecommunication services to its customers or any other changes in the aspects of Aliant Midwest's business activities which are subject to this Commission's jurisdiction will be caused by the proposed name change.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2544 be, and it is hereby, granted and Aliant Midwest Inc. d/b/a ALLTEL, is authorized to change its name to ALLTEL Communications of the Midwest, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
