BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 17, 2001, an application was filed by Corporate Calling Services, Inc. of Las Vegas, Nevada, seeking authority to change its name to U.S. Telecom Long Distance, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 20, 2001. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

The applicant was originally authorized by this Commission as a provider of resold long distance telecommunications services in Nebraska on November 24, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1910.

On July 16, 2001, Corporate Calling Services, Inc., amended its Articles of Incorporation to change its name to U.S. Telecom Long Distance, Inc. The applicant has received authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to use the new name. The applicant has no customer base in Nebraska. Thus, no advance customer notice is required.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2599 be, and it is hereby, granted and Corporate Calling Services, Inc. is authorized to change its name to U.S. Telecom Long Distance, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
