BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 10, 2001, TDI Communications, Inc. (TDI) of New York, New York, seeks authority to operate as a resold interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 11, 2001. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On December 5, 2001, Commission staff notified TDI that its application contained deficiencies that needed to be corrected before the Commission could render a decision on its application. Specifically, TDI did not provide current financial statements that showed a capitalization of at least \$200,000.

On February 26, 2002, the Commission received a letter from TDI stating that it wished to have its application withdrawn without prejudice. Pursuant to Rule 008 of the Rules of Commission Procedure, Title 291, Chapter 1, applications will not be withdrawn without approval of the Commission. In light of TDI's request, the Commission finds that the application should be withdrawn.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2613 be, and it is hereby, withdrawn.
