BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 6, 2001, an application was filed by DirectOne L.L.C. (DirectOne) of Santa Ana, California, seeking authority to include USTelenetworks, L.L.C. and One Rate L.D., L.L.C. as trade names. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 7, 2001. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The applicant was authorized by this Commission to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate, intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services on October 30, 2001, pursuant to Application No. C-2566.

In the current application, Direct One seeks to provide service in Nebraska under the trade names USTelenetworks, L.L.C. and One Rate L.D., L.L.C. The addition of the new trade names will have no impact on the financial, managerial or technical capabilities of the company. DirectOne has received authorization from the Secretary of State to use both trade names.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2635 be, and it is hereby, granted and DirectOne L.L.C. authorized to include USTelenetworks, L.L.C. and One Rate L.D., L.L.C. as trade names.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
