BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 9, 2002, an application was filed by Citizens Telecommunications Company of Nebraska (Citizens) of Burnsville, Minnesota, seeking authority to add the trade name Frontier Communications of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 10, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Citizens was authorized to operate as a local carrier of telecommunications services in Nebraska on June 5, 2000, pursuant to Application No. C-2312.

In the present application, Citizens seeks authorization to use the trade name Frontier Communications of Nebraska. Citizens has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new trade name. The addition of the trade name will have no effect on the financial, technical or managerial qualifications of Citizens. Based on the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion that the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2654 be, and it is hereby, granted and Citizens Telecommunications Company of Nebraska is authorized to add the trade name Frontier Communications of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
