BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 25, 2002, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation of Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of its revised statement of generally available terms (SGAT) pursuant to Section 252(f) of the 1996 Telecommunications Act. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 29, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On January 28, 2002, the Commission entered an order in Application No. C-2537 approving Qwest's SGAT, filed May 22, 2001, in its entirety. In the current application, Qwest has revised the SGAT in three different ways.

Compliance with Commission Orders:

The Commission had issued orders on August 20, 2001 (Group 3); October 16, 2001 (Emerging Services); October 30, 2001 (Group 1); November 20, 2001 (Group 2); December 4, 2001 (Group 4); and January 8, 2002 (Group 5) for Qwest to comply with various 271-related issues since its last SGAT revision. These orders recommended a number of changes to Qwest's SGAT. The revisions made by Qwest comply with those orders.

Changes Resulting for Consensus Language, Including Compliance Language Carried Forward From Other Proceedings:

The revised SGAT also takes into account several revisions made by Qwest that are consistent with the recommendations of other state commissions and the facilitator in the multi-state proceeding for the same checklist items.

Correction of Typographical, Grammatical and other Non-substantive Matters:

Furthermore, Qwest has made some revisions to correct a number of typographical errors, grammar mistakes and capitalization changes. In addition, Qwest has updated its web site addresses and technical standards to clarify language and ensure consistency. Finally, several definitions in Section 4.0 were moved to place them in correct alphabetical order.

C O N C L U S I O N

In light of previously approving Qwest's SGAT on January 8, 2002, and the fact that Qwest has satisfied the changes outlined in that order and all previous orders in the C-2537 docket, the Commission is of the opinion that the revised SGAT filed on January 25, 2002, should be approved. In addition, the Commission shall use the revised SGAT as the baseline document for any future proceedings regarding Qwest's SGAT.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Qwest's revised SGAT, filed in Application No. C-2666, is hereby, approved in its entirety, as set forth herein.
