## BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 10, 2002, an application was filed by MVX.COM Communications Inc. (MVX.COM) of Novato, California, seeking approval to change the name of its operating authority, previously granted in Application Nos. C-2171 and C-2279, to QuantumShift Communications, Inc. Notice of the application was published in <a href="https://doi.org/10.2002/pne.2002">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 6, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

The applicant was originally authorized by this Commission to operate as a local exchange carrier and a resale carrier of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on July 18, 2000, pursuant to Application Nos. C-2171 and C-2279.

Due to business considerations, MVX.COM wishes to change its name to QuantumShift Communications, Inc. The applicant has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. In addition, the name change will not adversely affect the company's financial, technical or managerial capabilities.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2674 be, and it is hereby, granted and MVX.COM Communications, Inc. is allowed to change its name to QuantumShift Communications, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
