BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On March 20, 2002, a joint application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado and DSLnet Communications, L.L.C. (DSLnet) of New Haven, Connecticut, jointly seeking approval of their wireline interconnection agreement based in the fifth revision of Qwest's Statement of Generally Available Terms and conditions, dated January 25, 2002. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 22, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(f) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and DSLnet entered into a Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions (SGAT) for interconnection, unbundled network elements, ancillary services and resale services. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the wireline interconnection agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the wireline interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and DSLnet Communications, L.L.C., be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed wireline interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
