BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 4, 2002 an application was filed by Weston Telecommunications, L.L.C. (Weston) of Richfield, Ohio, seeking authority to change its name to Easton Telecom Services, L.L.C. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 17, 2002.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On June 5, 2002, applicant was named as a defendant in Application No. C-2744/PI-61. Said docket sought to revoke operating authority and cease and desist operations in Nebraska for telecommunications companies that failed to file an annual report of operations pursuant to Commission rules and regulations.

Applicant failed to file an annual report for the year 2001. Subsequent mailings to both the applicant and applicant's counsel, seeking to resolve the complaint, went unanswered. As a result, on October 16, 2002, the Commission entered an order revoking the operating authority of Weston.

The Commission, being fully informed, is of the opinion that as the applicant is no longer authorized to provide telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska, this application should be dismissed a moot.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2724 be dismissed.
