BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 20, 2002, Keen LD, Inc. (Keen) of San Francisco, California, seeks authority to withdraw its certificate of authority for resold interexchange telecommunications service granted in Application C-2575. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 21, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Keen was authorized by this Commission to operate as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on August 4, 2001, pursuant to Application No. C-2575.

By letter dated May 16, 2002, Keen gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and therefore requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. Keen has no customers in the state of Nebraska and has no pending departmental, formal, or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Keen may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-2575.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2740 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to Keen LD, Inc., and its initial tariff are withdrawn.
