## BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On June 3, 2002, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado and Intrado Communications (Intrado) of Boulder, Colorado, seeking approval of a voluntarily-negotiated interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 4, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Intrado entered into a negotiated interconnection agreement. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the negotiated interconnection agreement should be approved.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the negotiated interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Intrado Communications Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
