BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 29, 2002, an application was filed by PT-1 Counsel Inc. (PT-1) of New York, New York, seeking approval to change the name of its operating authority to WorldxChange Corp. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 30, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

PT-1 is a New York corporation with its headquarters in New York, New York. PT-1 was authorized by this Commission to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate and interstate telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska on August 29, 2000, pursuant to Application No. C-2346.

In its current application, PT-1 asks the Commission to grant a name change. Due to business considerations, PT-1 has changed its name to WorldxChange Corp. A copy of the company's amended certificate of authority issued by the Secretary of State is enclosed with the application.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion that the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2803 be, and it is hereby, granted and PT-1 Counsel is authorized to change its name to WorldxChange Corp.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
