BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 8, 2002, an application was filed by Long Distance of Michigan, Inc., d/b/a LDMI Long Distance (LDMI) of Hamtramck, Michigan, seeking authority to change its name to LDMI Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a LDMI Long Distance. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 9, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

LDMI is a Michigan corporation with its headquarters in Hamtramck, Michigan. LDMI was authorized by this Commission to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate and interstate telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska on January 27, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1672.

In its current application, LDMI asks the Commission to grant a name change. Due to business considerations, LDMI has changed its name to LDMI Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a LDMI Long Distance. A copy of the company's amended certificate of authority issued by the Secretary of State is enclosed with the application.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion that the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2823 be, and it is hereby granted and Long Distance of Michigan, Inc., d/b/a LDMI Long Distance, is authorized to change its name to LDMI Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a LDMI Long Distance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
