On December 18, 2002, an application was filed by Sprint Spectrum L.P., a Delaware Limited Partnership, as agent for Wirelessco, LP, a Delaware Limited Partnership and Sprintcom, Inc., a Kansas Corporation and Cox Communications PCS, L.P., a Delaware Limited Partnership and APC PCS, L.L.C. a Delaware Limited Partnership and Phillieco, L.P., a Delaware Limited Partnership, all foregoing entities jointly doing business as Sprint PCS and United Telephone Company of the West, Sprint, seeking approval of a Commercial Mobile Radio Services Interconnection Agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 20, No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), these entities negotiated a Commercial Mobile Radio Services Agreement. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the negotiated interconnection agreement should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Commercial Mobile Radio Interconnection Agreement between Sprint Spectrum L.P., as agent for Wirelessco, LP, and Sprintcom, Inc., and Cox Communications PCS, L.P. and APC PCS, L.L.C. and Phillieco, L.P., all foregoing entities jointly doing business as Sprint PCS and United Telephone Company of the West, d/b/a Sprint, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
