BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 26, 2002, an application was filed by Qwest LD Corp. (Qwest LD) of Denver, Colorado, seeking authority for a name change to add doing business as (d/b/a) name Qwest Long Distance to its certificate of operating authority. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 30, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Qwest LD was authorized by this Commission to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services on November 19, 2002, pursuant to Application No. C-2820.

In the present application, Qwest LD seeks authorization to use an additional trade name of Qwest Long Distance. Qwest LD has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new trade name. The subsequent filing of a stand-alone tariff offered under the new trade name will not affect current customers of Qwest LD Corp. Based on all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2855 be, and it is hereby, granted and Qwest LD Corp. is authorized to do business as Qwest Long Distance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
