On February 3, 2003, an application was filed by Enhanced Communications Group, L.L.C. (Enhanced) of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, seeking authority to conduct business under the name of ECG. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 4, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Enhanced was authorized by this Commission to operate as interexchange carrier of telecommunications services on October 31, 2000, pursuant to Application No. C-2269.

In the present application, Enhanced seeks authorization to use an additional doing business name (d/b/a) of ECG. Enhanced has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new d/b/a. As Enhanced intends to file a stand-alone tariff under the new name, there will be no effect on current customers of Enhanced. Based on the all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion that the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2878 be, and it is hereby, granted and Enhanced Communications Group, L.L.C., is authorized to do business as ECG.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file its new tariff reflecting the new name within 30 days of the date of this order.
