## BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 11, 2003, an application was filed by VP Telecom, Inc. (VP) of Sioux Falls, South Dakota, seeking authority to amend Certificate Nos. C-2756 and C-2776 by changing its name to OrbitCom, Inc. Notice of the application was published in <a href="https://doi.org/10.103/journal.org/">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 13, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

VP was authorized by this Commission to provide intrastate interexchange service on August 6, 2002, pursuant to Application No. C-2756 and local exchange service on September 11, 2002, in Application No. C-2776.

In its current application VP wishes to amend its certificates of authority to change its name to OrbitCom, Inc. This transaction will be transparent to its customers and will result in no change in the rates terms and conditions in which its customers will receive service.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2883 be, and it is hereby, granted and VP Telecom, Inc. is authorized to change its name to OrbitCom, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
