BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed February 24, 2003, Sonix 4U (Sonix) of Madison Heights, Michigan, seeks authority to withdraw its certificate of authority granted in Application No. C-2587 and its associated tariff. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 8, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Sonix was authorized by this Commission to operate as an intrastate reseller of telecommunications services in Nebraska on March 19, 2002, pursuant to Application No. C-2587.

By letter dated February 24, 2003, Sonix gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and, therefore, requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. Sonix no longer conducts business in the state and does not have any revenues or customers in Nebraska. Sonix has no pending departmental, formal, or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Sonix may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-2587.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2891 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to Sonix 4U and its initial tariff are withdrawn.
