BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 20, 2003, an application was filed by ComTech21, L.L.C. (ComTech21) of Wallingford, Connecticut, seeking to transfer the customer base of Alliance Group Services, Inc., d/b/a AGSi (AGSi) to ComTech21. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 30, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

ComTech21, is a Delaware corporation with its headquarters in Wallingford, Connecticut. ComTech21, has authority in Nebraska as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services pursuant to Application No. C-2334 granted on November 21, 2000.

AGSi is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business in Westport, Connecticut. AGSi has authority in Nebraska as a reseller of telecommunications services pursuant to Application No. C-1872 granted on October 7, 1998.

In the current application, AGSi has agreed to divest certain retail assets to Comtech21. The parties intend to transfer approximately 39 AGSi Nebraska customers to ComTech21. Upon approval of this transaction, ComTech21 will provide notice to all effected customers informing them of their choice to switch carriers. ComTech21 will reimburse customers for any primary interexchange carrier "PIC" change charges if imposed by local exchange carriers in connection with this transaction.

Based on the evidence presented, we find the application to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest. The application should be granted. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2998 be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant reimburse PIC charges of any customer wishing to switch carriers as a result of this transaction.
