By application filed April 1, 2003, Telco Partners, Inc. (Telco) of Blue Bell, Pennsylvania, seeks to surrender its certificate of authority granted in C-1673. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 4, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N    A N D    F I N D I N G S

Telco was authorized by this Commission to operate as a reseller of telecommunications services in Nebraska on June 27, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1673.

By letter dated March 28, 2003, Telco gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and therefore requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. Telco has not conducted business in the state and does not have any revenues or customers in Nebraska. Telco has no pending departmental, formal, or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Telco may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-1673.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2911 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to Telco Partners, Inc. and its initial tariff are withdrawn.
