BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 15, 2003, a joint application was filed by Qwest Corporation of (Qwest) Denver, Colorado, and Huntel CableVision, d/b/a Huntel Communications (Huntel) of Blair, Nebraska, seeking approval of a wireline adoption interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 17, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Huntel adopted the wireline interconnection agreement of Cox Nebraska Telcom Inc. and Qwest Co., f/k/a US West Communications Inc., granted on August 8, 1997. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the adopted wireline interconnection agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that adopted wireline interconnection between Qwest Corporation and Huntel CableVision, d/b/a Huntel Communications, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed master interconnection and resale agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
