By application filed May 20, 2003, RSL COMUSA, Inc. (RSL) of New York, New York, seeks authority to withdraw its authority granted in Application No. C-2471 and associated tariffs. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 21, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N    A N D    F I N D I N G S

RSL was authorized by this Commission to provide telecommunications services throughout the state of Nebraska on March 6, 2001, pursuant to Application No. C-2471.

By letter dated April 21, 2003, RSL gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and therefore requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. RSL has no customers and has ceased operations in Nebraska. RSL has no pending departmental, formal, or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that RSL may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-2471.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2953 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to RSL COMUSA, Inc. and its initial tariff are withdrawn.
