BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 23, 2003, an Application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of a negotiated interconnection agreement and negotiated Amendment Number One to the Agreement for Directory Assistance List Information with LSSi Corp. (LSSi) of Lumberton, New Jersey. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 28, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Upon concerns raised regarding Qwest's decision not to file contractual agreements with companies that it believes do not fall within the filing requirements of Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, (The Act) Qwest agreed to file such agreements. It is Qwest's intention to file such agreements out of an abundance of caution to make certain that there are no questions regarding compliance with any filing obligations.

In the current application, Qwest seeks approval of a Directory Assistance List Information agreement with LSSi. The underlying agreement provides LSSi with (1) end user name, (2) end user address, and (3) end user published or non-listed telephone number, or an indication of non-published status. The Amendment would amend the underlying agreement on the permitted and restricted uses of DA List information, such that LSSi can use the information for the purposes of directory assistance services and directory publishing.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the agreement and amendment filed July 23, 2003, should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the negotiated agreement and amendment between Qwest Corporation and LSSi Corp. be and is hereby approved.
