## BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 28, 2003, an application was filed by Eschelon Telecom, Inc. (Eschelon) of Minneapolis, Minnesota, seeking authority to withdraw its certificate of authority granted in Application Nos. C-2306 and C-2307. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 30, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

### OPINION AND FINDINGS

Eschelon is a provider of local and interstate telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. The Commission received a letter from Eschelon on July 15, 2003, requesting that it be allowed to withdraw its certificates of authority. Eschelon has never conducted business in the state and does not have any revenues or customers in Nebraska. Eschelon has no pending departmental, formal or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Eschelon may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application Nos. C-2306 and C-2307.

#### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2990 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificates of authority of Eschelon Telecommunications, Inc. in Application Nos. C-2306 and C-2307 are withdrawn.
