By application filed August 25, 2003, Viva Telecom, LLC (Viva) of Salt Lake City, Utah, seeking authority to withdraw authority previously granted in Application No. C-2585. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 2, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Viva was authorized by this Commission to operate as a reseller of telecommunications services in Nebraska on November 30, 2001, pursuant to Application No. C-2585.

By letter dated August 22, 2003, Viva gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and therefore requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. Viva has never conducted business in the state and does not have any revenues or customers in Nebraska. Viva has no pending departmental, formal or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Viva may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-2585.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3010 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to Viva Telecom, LLC, and its initial tariff are withdrawn.
