BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 29, 2003, Broadwing Communication Services, Inc. (Broadwing) of Austin, Texas, seeks to cancel its authority. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 2, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Broadwing was authorized by this Commission to operate as a reseller of telecommunications services in Nebraska on November 21, 1995, pursuant to Application No. C-1187 under the name IXC Long Distance Inc., and on November 30, 1999, in Application No. C-2066 under the name Broadwing-CSI.

By letter dated August 28, 2003, Broadwing gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and therefore requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. Broadwing had transferred its assets to C III Ops pursuant to Application No. C-2900, granted on May 13, 2003. The transaction has been completed. No customers in Nebraska will be affected by this cancellation of authority.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Broadwing may withdraw the certificates previously issued to it in Application Nos. C-1187 and C-2066.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3013 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to Broadwing Communication Services, Inc., and its initial tariff are withdrawn.
