BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 30, 2003, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of an Amendment to its Statement of Generally Available Terms (SGAT), pursuant to Section 252(f) of the 1996 Telecommunications Act. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 9, 2003. On October 2, 2003, Qwest filed a revised Exhibit B to Qwest's Nebraska SGAT, which provides for Service Performance Indicator Definitions (PIDs.) On October 6, 2003, Qwest filed an errata to its previously filed Exhibit B. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 4, 2003, the Commission entered an order in Application No. C-2750, approving Qwest's revised SGAT, filed on May 31, 2002. In the current application, Owest amended its revised SGAT with consensus language that was developed through the Regional Oversight Committee (ROC) collaborative process. Furthermore, Qwest has modified its SGAT to be consistent with the orders and recommendations of state commissions and the the multi-state proceeding. facilitator in Finally, amendment to the revised SGAT filed herein includes Qwest's Performance Assurance Plan (QPAP) as Exhibit K and a revised Exhibit B that provides for reporting performance on both installation quality and order quality.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that Qwest's amended revised SGAT should be approved as set forth herein.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Qwest's amended revised SGAT, filed in Application No. C-3029, is hereby, approved.
