BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 7, 2003, Harold Schriner of Guide Rock, Nebraska, seeks authority to receive telephone service from the Lawrence Exchange of Glenwood Telephone Membership Corporation. Applicant resides within the Guide Rock Exchange of Alltel. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, on October 9, 2003. On November 25, 2003, Alltel filed a response stating, inter alia, that a grant of the application would create a duplication of facilities or dual service area.

A hearing on the application was held January 21, 2004, in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska. At the hearing, it became evident that the applicant, Glenwood Telephone Membership Corporation, and Alltel could agree on a less intrusive alternative than a change in the local exchange boundary. Alltel stated at the hearing that Glenwood Telephone Membership Corporation could, without their objection, run a line to the applicant's home to provide DSL service. All parties to this proceeding committed to working together to develop an amicable resolution for Mr. Schriner. Shortly thereafter, the applicant filed a letter with the Commission seeking permission to withdraw this boundary change request.

Upon consideration of the information gathered at the hearing and the applicant's letter of withdrawal, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed. The Commission further finds that Glenwood Telephone Membership Corporation should submit a letter to the Commission describing the resolution reached in this matter.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above-captioned application be and it is hereby dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Glenwood Telephone Membership Corporation submit a letter to the Commission describing the resolution reached in this matter.
