BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 5, 2003, an application was filed jointly by David Butler (Butler), individually, of Daytona Beach, Florida, BSM Family Limited Partnership (BSM) of Las Vegas, Nevada, Visia Communications, LLC (Visia) of Maitland, Florida, and Reduced Rate Long Distance, LLC (Reduced Rate) of Maitland, Florida, seeking to transfer control of Visia and its wholly owned subsidiary, Reduced Rate, to Dominion Business Group, Inc. (Dominion), of Orlando, Florida. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 9, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

The Parties:

Reduced Rate is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Visia, which in turn is wholly owned by Butler and BSM. Visia and Reduced Rate are Nevada Limited Liability Companies and are headquartered in Maitland, Florida. Reduced Rate is a provider of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska as authorized by the Commission in Application No. C-2524 on June 5, 2001. Visia is a holding company and has no certificates of authority.

Butler is an individual whose business address is located in Daytona Beach, Florida. BSM is a Nevada Limited Partnership with its principal office located in Las Vegas, Nevada. Butler and BSM have no certificates of authority.

Dominion is a Nevada Corporation with its principal offices located in Orlando, Florida. Dominion is a holding company, which holds no certificates of authority.

Description of the Transaction:

Grant of the requested authority will permit consummation of a transaction whereby Dominion will acquire 100% of the membership interest in Visia, which includes Visia's 100% membership interest in Reduced Rate, from Butler and BSM. The proposed transfer will not change Reduced Rate's name, rates and service offerings, customer service numbers, physical assets, property, or personnel. There will be no interruption of service to Reduced Rates customers. Additionally, the proposed transaction will not result in any change in the direct ownership and control of Reduced Rate. Reduced Rate will still be wholly owned by Visia, which in turn will be wholly owned by Dominion.

Based on the evidence, we find the application to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3059 be, and it is hereby, granted.
