BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 17, 2003, the Commission docketed a request by United Way of the Midlands, on behalf of Three Rivers Public Health Department, for use of "211" as the dialing code for First Call for Help (FCFH) services in Dodge, Washington and Saunders Counties. The Commission previously assigned "211" to United Way of the Midlands for use in Douglas and Sarpy Counties, by order entered February 20, 2002, and in Dodge and Cass Counties, by order entered July 23, 2002.

First Call for Help, a program of the United Way of the Midlands Volunteer Resource Center, is a comprehensive information and referral service.

In order to proceed on this request, this docket will evaluate the public benefits of designating "211" for Dodge, Washington and Saunders Counties. The Commission will hold a joint hearing in this matter with United Way of the Midlands previous request docketed in Application No. C-3061/PI-75, on January 28, 2004, at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.
