BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed January 14, 2004, El Paso Networks, LLC, (El Paso) of Houston, Texas, seeks to surrender its certificate of operating authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service, previously granted C-2617, and its certificate of Application No. operating authority to provide resold and facilities based, dedicated and local exchange telecommunications line previously granted in Application No. C-2616, in the State of Notice of the application was published in The Daily Nebraska. Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 15, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

El Paso was granted a certificate of operating authority to provide interexchange carrier telecommunications service in Nebraska by the Commission on December 4, 2001, pursuant to Application No. C-2617. The Commission also granted to El Paso a certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide resold and facilities based, dedicated and private line local exchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on December 4, 2001, pursuant to Application No. C-2616.

By letter dated January 5, 2004, El Paso gave notice that it currently wishes to surrender both its operating authority to provide interexchange carrier telecommunication service in Nebraska and its certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide resold and facilities-based, dedicated and private line local exchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. El

Paso has not provided telecommunications services to customers in Nebraska, nor does it have any loop, transport, or switching facilities in the state.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that El Paso may withdraw the certificates previously issued to it in Application Nos. C-2617 and C-2616.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3087 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide resold and facilities based, dedicated and private line local exchange telecommunications services granted to El Paso Networks, LLC, are withdrawn.
