On January 28, 2004, the Commission docketed a request by United Way of the Midlands for use of "211" as the dialing code for First Call for Help (FCFH) services in the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County. The Commission previously assigned "211" to United Way of the Midlands for use in Douglas and Sarpy Counties, by order entered February 20, 2002, and in Dodge and Cass Counties, by order entered July 23, 2002.

First Call for Help, a program of the United Way of the Midlands Volunteer Resource Center, is a comprehensive information and referral service.
