O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 21, 2004, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Special Promotion Amendment for Available Inventory Collocation Sites with Sprint Communications Company, L.P., (Sprint), Overland Park, Kansas, previously granted in Application No. C-1417. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 25, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On September 23, 1996, pursuant to Application No. C-1417, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest (then known as US West) and Sprint was approved by this Commission. Subsequent to the original filing, the Commission approved amendments to the agreement pursuant to Application Nos. C-2452, C-2473, C-2474, C-2488, and C-2510. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding a Special Promotion Amendment for Available Inventory Collocation Sites. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed May 21, 2004, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Sprint Communications Company, be, and it is hereby, approved.
