OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 19, 2004, Qwest Communications (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Special Promotion Amendment for Available Inventory Collation Sites to its interconnection agreement with Alltel Communications of the Midwest, Inc., f/k/a Aliant Midwest, Inc., d/b/a Alltel (Alltel), of Little Rock, Arkansas, which was previously granted in Application No. C-1530. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 24, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On November 18, 1997, pursuant to Application No. C-1530, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest (then known as US West) and Alltel (then known as Aliant Midwest) was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding a Special Promotion Amendment for Available Inventory Collocation Sites. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed March 19, 2004, should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Communications and Alltel Communications of the Midwest, Inc., f/k/a Aliant Midwest, Inc., d/b/a Alltel, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
