BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On March 23, 2004, a joint application was filed by Alltel Communications, Inc. (Alltel), of Little Rock, Arkansas, and K&M Telephone Company (K&M), of Chambers, Nebraska, seeking approval of their Wireless Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement. Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Alltel and K&M entered into a wireless interconnection and reciprocal compensation agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as, all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the wireless interconnection and reciprocal compensation agreement filed on March 23, 2004, should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the wireless interconnection and reciprocal compensation agreement between Alltel Communications, Inc., and K&M Telephone Company, be, and it is hereby, approved.
