BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On March 30, 2004, a joint application was filed by Citizens Telecommunications Company of Nebraska, d/b/a Frontier Communications of Nebraska (Citizens) of Mound, Minnesota, and Houlton Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Guaranteed Phone Services (Houlton) of Council Bluffs, Iowa, seeking approval of their agreement for resale. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 31, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Citizens and Houlton entered into an agreement for resale arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as, all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the wireless interconnection and reciprocal compensation agreement filed on March 30, 2004, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the agreement for resale between Citizens Telecommunications Company of Nebraska, d/b/a Frontier Communications of Nebraska, and Houlton Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Guaranteed Phone Services, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
