BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 31, 2004, Network Communications International Corp. (NCIC) of Longview, Texas, filed an application seeking to add the trade names of Mundo Telecom and 1800Call4Less to their certificate of authority. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 1, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

NCIC was authorized to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska by the Commission on November 24, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1915. In the current application, NCIC wishes to amend their certificate of authority to include the trade names of Mundo Telecom and 1800Call4Less. NCIC applied for registration of the trade names and was granted authorization by the Secretary of State of Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3177 be, and it is hereby, granted and Network Communications International Corp., is authorized to add the trade names of Mundo Telecom and 1800Call4Less.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order with the appropriate fee.
