BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On April 8, 2004, an application was filed by ALLTEL Communications, Inc. (ALLTEL) of Little Rock, Arkansas, seeking approval of its Wireless Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement with Great Plains Communications, Inc. (Great Plains) of Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 9, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Great Plains received a request from ALLTEL to adopt the terms and conditions of the Interconnection Agreement between Great Plains and WWC License L.L.C. (Western Wireless), previously approved by the Commission in Application Number C-2872, which became effective September 23, 2003. An executed copy of this agreement as amended is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the interconnection agreement between ALLTEL Communications, Inc., and Great Plains Communications Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
