O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On April 16, 2004, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Qwest DSL (with discount) provided with UNE-P Amendment to its interconnection agreement with MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC (MCImetro) of San Ramon, California, previously granted in Application No. C-2257. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 21, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On April 11, 2000, pursuant to Application No. C-2257, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest (then known as US West) and MCImetro was approved by this Commission. In the current joint application, the parties seek to amend the agreement by adding terms, conditions and rates for Qwest DSL (with discount) provided with UNE-P. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act) requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed April 16, 2004, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
