## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On April 29, 2004, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Qwest DSL (with discount) provided with UNE-P Amendment with Sprint Communications Company, L.P. (Sprint), previously granted in Application No. C-3089. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 12, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On February 24, 2004, this Commission, pursuant to Application No. C-3089, approved the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Sprint. In the current joint application, the parties seek to amend the agreement by adding terms, conditions and rates for Qwest DSL (with discount) provided with UNE-P. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act) requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed April 29, 2004, should be approved.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Sprint Communications Company, L.P., be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
