On May 18, 2004, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened the above-captioned docket, on its own motion, to administer the Nebraska Internet Enhancement Fund (NIEF) established by the Legislature pursuant to *Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-579 through 86-580 (2002 Supp.)*. The Commission in its August 5, 2008, Order established a schedule for the 2008 application process and grant awards under the NIEF Grant Program.





