## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 11, 2005, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) awarded a Nebraska Internet Enhancement Fund (NIEF) grant to Dawes County, in the amount of \$50,000.

Dawes County filed its signed Grant Agreement on March 25, 2005. The Commission issued an order granting an extension of the filing deadline for the Notice of Commencement on August 9, 2005. Dawes County filed its Notice of Commencement on December 15, 2005.

On March 21, 2006, Dawes County submitted its Final Completion report and supporting documentation. The County requested payment of \$50,000 in grant funds. Pursuant to the Grant Agreement, Dawes County opted for a lump sum payout of grant funds upon completion of the grant project. Dawes County has to date not received any grant funds. The Commission finds that final payment in the amount of \$50,000 should be made to Dawes County.

The County shall also submit, pursuant to section 4.05 of the Grant Agreement, a "Project Impact" report six (6) months from the date of completion of the project, February 1, 2006. The County shall outline the benefits received from individuals, businesses, and community agencies as a result of the Project, the number of individuals, businesses, and community agencies using the services installed and estimates regarding the sustainability and growth of the Project.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that final payment in the amount of \$50,000 in NIEF grant funds shall be made to Dawes County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the County shall no later than August 1, 2006, also submit, pursuant to section 4.05 of the

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grant agreement, a "Project Impact" report six (6) months from the date of completion of the project, February 1, 2006.
