BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed June 21, 2004, Comdata Telecommunications Services, Inc. (Comdata) of Brentwood, Tennessee, seeks to withdraw its certificate of authority to operate as a resale carrier within the State of Nebraska, previously granted by the Commission in Application No. C-1275. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 30, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 19, 1996, Comdata was granted a certificate to operate as a resale carrier within the State of Nebraska, pursuant to Application No. C-1275.

By letter received on June 21, 2004, Comdata requested the withdrawal of its certificate of authority. Comdata no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Comdata's certificate of authority previously granted in Application No. C-1275 should be withdrawn.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3230 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority previously granted to Comdata Telecommunications Services, Inc., is withdrawn.
