BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 3, 2004, Operator Communications, Inc. (Operator) of San Francisco, California, seeks to withdraw its certificate of authority to operate as a resale carrier within the State of Nebraska, previously granted by the Commission in Application No. C-745; and subsequently modified in Application Nos. C-1096 and C-1217. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 6, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On August 9, 1988, Operator was granted a certificate to operate as a resale carrier within the State of Nebraska, pursuant to Application No. C-745. The application was subsequently modified under Application Nos. C-1096 and C-1217.

By letter received on August 3, 2004, Operator requested the withdrawal of its certificate of authority. Operator no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Comdata's certificate of authority previously granted in Application No. C-745 should be canceled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3247 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority previously granted to Operator Services, Inc., is canceled.
