BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 4, 2004, Long Distance Wholesale Club (LDWC) of Dallas, Texas, seeks to withdraw its certificate of authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska, previously granted in C-1303. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 6, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On September 3, 1987, LDWC was granted a certificate to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska pursuant to Application No. C-1303.

By letter received on August 4, 2004, LDWC requested the withdrawal of its certificate of authority. LDWC no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that LDWC's certificate of authority previously granted in Application No. C-1303 should be withdrawn.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3248 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority previously granted to Long Distance Wholesale Club.
