## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 27, 2004, Ameritech Communications International, Inc. (ACII), Pleasanton, California, seeks to cancel its certificate of authority to provide Telephone Toll Resale Service in the State of Nebraska previously granted in Application No. C-1354. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 3, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On September 5, 1996, ACII was granted a certificate to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska pursuant to Application No. C-1354.

By letter received on August 23, 2004, ACII requested the withdrawal of its certificate of authority. On December 26, 2002 ACII, a subsidiary of SBC Communications, Inc. (SBC) was dissolved and merged into SBC. ACII has not provided or no longer provides local or long distance service in the State of Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that ACII's certificate of authority previously granted in Application No. C-1354 should be withdrawn.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3259 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority previously granted to Ameritech Communications International, Inc. is hereby withdrawn
