BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed September 20, 2004, United Systems Access Telecom, Inc. (USAT) of Kennebunk, Maine, seeks to withdraw its authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications within the State of Nebraska, previously granted by the Commission in Application No. C-2622. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 22, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 8, 2002, USAT was granted a certificate of authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska, pursuant to Application No. C-2622.

By letter received on September 20, 2004, USAT requested the withdrawal of its certificate of authority. USAT no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that USAT's certificate of authority previously granted in Application No. C-2622 should be canceled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3265 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority previously granted to United Systems Access Telecom, Inc., is canceled.
