BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed September 20, 2004, MG, LLC. d/b/a SearsConnect (MG) of Fort Lee, New Jersey, seeks to withdraw its authority to operate as a resale common carrier within the State of Nebraska, previously granted by the Commission in Application No. C-3015. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 22, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On November 13, 2003, MG was granted a certificate to operate as a resale common carrier within the State of Nebraska, pursuant to Application No. C-3015.

By letter received on September 17, 2004, MG requested the withdrawal of its certificate of authority. MG no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that MG's certificate of authority previously granted in Application No. C-3015 should be canceled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3266 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority previously granted to MG, LLC. d/b/a SearsConnect, is canceled.
